



Resolution of Appreciation

Presented to Livonia City Clerk Susan M. Nash & Staff

Whereas, voter approval of Proposal 3 in 2018 increased opportunities for civic participation while also posing challenges to the Secretary of State, County Clerks, and City and Township Clerks and their staffs for effective implementation, and

Whereas, COVID-19 became a critical issue in 2020 for all the people of Livonia and beyond, and

Whereas, Livonia City Clerk Susan M. Nash and her staff had to address COVID-19 in preparing for and implementing the 2020 election procedures for the Livonia citizens, and

Whereas, the preparations for the 2020 Presidential election were effectively overseen by Clerk Susan M. Nash and her staff, and

Whereas, Clerk Susan M. Nash has reported that 78% of registered voters in Livonia cast ballots in the Presidential election, including 42,708 absentee ballots and 21,986 in-person ballots at the polling places, and

Whereas, Clerk Susan M. Nash and her staff worked diligently to provide information to citizens, and were transparent and courteous, even while facing potential criticism and complaints throughout,
